DIPLOMA IN SENIOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

UNITS

To achieve the qualification candidates must complete 4 Mandatory units plus a minimum of six units from two optional groups from Group B

A – Mandatory units

- Manage teams in construction
- Lead and participate in meetings in construction management
- Provide ethical advice, judgement and service in construction management
- Develop self and others in construction management

B – Optional units

- Learners must select units from two of the three groups B1, B2 and B3.
- Credit value required: minimum 85. (6 units)

B1 – Optional group for project developm

- Prepare and agree a project brief and development programme in construction
- Manage design development and processes in construction
- Assess and evaluate the environmental impact of developments in construction management
- Evaluate sustainable resources and requirements in construction management
- Manage marketing and customer service in construction organisations

B2 – Optional group for procurement contracts and bu

- Establish project procurement arrangements in construction management
- Implement strategic sourcing partnerships in construction management
- Manage procurement processes in construction management
- Prepare and submit estimates, bids and tenders in construction management
- Ensure that contracts are prepared, negotiated and concluded in construction management
- Control organisational and project income and expenditure in construction management

B3 – Option group for project cont

- Manage project risks and opportunities in construction
- Manage project processes in construction
- Manage project evaluation and feedback in construction
- Control project outcomes in construction
- Valuate and progress the resolution of disputes in construction management
- Manage project completion in construction

THE PROCESS

On arrival to site the NVQ assessor will require a quiet area of site (office, canteen) to conduct an induction on to the NVQ this will include assessment plan, gdpr compliance, assessment and appeals procedure, skill scan and a knowledge Q&A /Professional discussion this process takes around 2 hours. You will be assessed in the workplace through a number of assessment methods such as; observations, professional discussions (Knowledge Q&A – 15 questions per unit), witness testimonies and company reference, written questions and collection of work generated evidence this can include documentary evidence e.g. Rams, lift plans, attendance records, plant/lifting equipment maintenance records, traffic management plans, cdm plans tool box talks, team briefings, videos and pictures.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Must have experience in construction senior management
- Minimum 6 months work experience
- You must be currently working onsite
- Good level of spoken and written English
- Valid passport or driving licence (ID)
